

The TWU believes Canadian companies, like TELUS, that make money from Canadian consumers should use their profits to provide jobs to Canadian workers. TELUS makes over \$1 billion a year in profit, yet new job opportunities here in Canada are being lost because TELUS prefers hiring workers overseas to avoid Canadian labour laws and minimum standards while paying a fraction of what it pays workers in Canada.

Service suffers, the economy suffers, workers have less access to goodpaying jobs. TELUS has already sent 1,000 jobs to Manila. When does the bleeding stop? When do Canadian companies become accountable to Canadians?
